

## What is the Subsidy Program?

The St. Albert Family Resource Centre (SAFRC) has a subsidy for individuals and families wanting to take a SAFRC program who are on a limited income.

## Who Qualifies for the Program?

Applicants must:

- Not be eligible for the Stay-at-Home Parents Support subsidy through Alberta Human Services\*.
- Meet the annual household income threshold requirement.
- Annual household net income (after taxes):
  - Family of 2 – less than \$30,240.00
  - Family of 3 – less than \$38,197.00
  - Family of 4 – less than \$43,036.00
  - Family of 5 – less than \$47,454.00
  - Family of 6 – less than \$50,799.00

## What does the Subsidy Program offer?

Those that receive the subsidy:

- Will typically be provided with the annual assistance of up to \$100 per person, or up to \$300 for a family with four or more members.
- Will receive an annual SAFRC membership, which is not covered by the Stay-at-Home Parents Support subsidy through Alberta Human Services.

- All registered programs offered by the St. Albert Family Resource Centre.
